

Extraordinary sculptures



Olivier Strebell was an artist born in Belgium. His sculptures can be seen in a variety of locations, from urban spaces to large institutions in Europe, the United States and Asia.

His sculptures are characterized by their monumental size and linear design.

At the lobby of the Paul-Henri Spaak building in Brussels, better known as the European Parliament building, we can see one of his works entitled "Confluences". Composed of polished stainless steel tubes, this sculpture emerges from the center, giving the viewer the sensation that it is just another element of the architecture of the

staircase.

The author wanted to donate this sculpture to the European Union because of the symbolism it represented: "the common trunk, the Union; the branches, the Member States and their confluence, the interdependent diplomatic collaboration".
