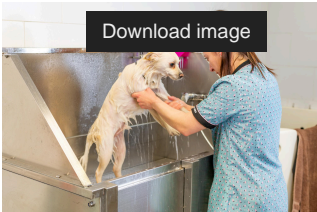


¡Guau! Shower for my pet

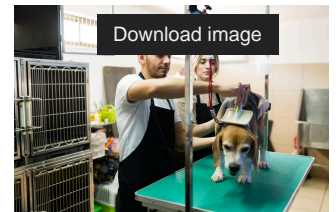

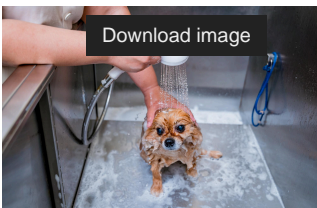
use.

Veterinary centres, dog grooming salons, animal residences and self-washing centres incorporate areas for pet hygiene. In all these spaces, stainless steel is the best base to ensure strength, cleanliness and durability.

Unlike a domestic shower, a pet shower must withstand intensive use, being in constant contact with water, cleaning products and, of course, animals in movement. That is why stainless steel stands out for its resistance to corrosion, its smooth surface with the option to provide a non-slip finish, easy to disinfect, and its ability to remain in good condition over time.



Stainless steel is also used in complementary structures such as anti-slip ramps, support tables, shelves or drainage systems. Its versatility allows the creation of comfortable, safe and easy to maintain spaces. In addition, it helps to meet the hygiene standards required in centres with high flow of animals or with special sanitary needs.



Indoors, grade 304 stainless steel is the most common choice. For outdoor areas or more demanding environments, such as those with aggressive products, grade 316 is recommended, which offers greater resistance to corrosion.

In spaces where cleanliness is essential, stainless steel is still the safest and most practical option.
